FORMAT OF PLAY

Men's Division Qualifying Round: 18 hole stroke play (Starting times see attached)

REGISTRATION

Please check in at the registration table upon your arrival at Soldier Hill GC. *Players Must Report* to the first tee, ten minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.

BREAKFAST / LUNCH

Complimentary breakfast and lunch will be available for all players. Please do not be late for scheduled starting time.

PRACTICE

Soldier Hill Golf Course does NOT supply balls for the practice range.

START OF PLAY

Rule 5.3a states that "the player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rules 5.3a is disqualification.

WITHDRAWAL

CARTS AND CADDIES

Carts are available for all players. Players may bring their own caddie or carry their own bag.

DRESS CODE

Suitable golf attire must be worn at all times.

SCORE CARDS

Official scorecards will be distributed at the registration desk. Exchange the individual cards within your group so you do not keep your own card. Upon completing the round, the competitor shall:

1. check his score for each hole
2. settle any doubtful points with the Rules Committee
3. insure that the marker has signed the card
4. countersign the card himself
5. return it to the Official at the Scoring Table. Two signatures, please.

PACE OF PLAY

Slow play will not be tolerated and will be penalized appropriately. Do not allow a hole to open in front of you. Rule 5.6b of the Rules of Golf states in part: "The player shall play without undue delay." The penalty for breach of this Rule is one or two strokes in medal play.

Any group out of position will be alerted to that fact and requested to play at a faster pace. Any such group will be monitored i.e., the time each player takes to play each stroke will be recorded. Any player in a group out of position who takes more than 40 seconds (50 seconds in the case of a player who is the first to play on or near the putting green or from the teeing ground on a par 3 hole) to play a stroke on TWO (2) different occasions will automatically incur a penalty of one stroke under Rule 5, THREE (3) occasions = two strokes and FOUR (4) = Disqualification.

The timing of a player's stroke will begin when he has had reasonable opportunity to reach his ball, it is his turn to play and he could play without interference by another person or another ball.

Undue delay may occur between strokes. Accordingly, a player may be subject to penalty under Rule 5.6b, even if he plays each of his strokes in less than 40 seconds.

Please cooperate. If all players cooperate, the BC Amateur Championship will be a more pleasant experience for everyone.

YOUR POSITION IS DIRECTLY BEHIND THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU

DIRECTIONS TO SOLDIER HILL GOLF COURSE

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY to exit 165/Oradell-Ridgewood. Follow signs for Oradell. Take Oradell Avenue east 4 traffic lights to Kinderkamack Rd. and make a left onto Kinderkamack Rd. Go approximately 2 miles to traffic light which is Old Hook Rd and turn right onto Old Hook Rd. Continue approximately ½ mile to Emerson Rd (passing hospital on left) and make a left onto Emerson Rd. Follow Emerson Rd to end and at stop sign make a right onto Rivervale Rd. Golf course is ½ mile on right.

GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE to Rt 4 west for approximately 6.5 miles to Kinderkamack Rd/River Edge exit. At traffic light make left onto Kinderkamack Rd. Proceed approximately 5.5 miles to traffic light and make a right onto Old Hook Rd. Continue approximately ½ to Emerson Rd (passing hospital on left) and make a left onto Emerson Rd. Follow Emerson Rd to end and at stop sign make right onto Rivervale Rd. Golf Course is ½ mile on right.

NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE north to Rt 80 west to Garden State Parkway north. Follow directions under Garden State Parkway.

TAPPEN ZEE BRIDGE follow Rt 87 to Garden State Parkway south. Take the Garden State Parkway to exit 165. Follow directions under Garden State Parkway.
