## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION SHEET

### FORMAT OF PLAY

Scramble: In a scramble, each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. **A minimum of TWO DRIVES per team member is required.**

Division: Men's Division  
Women's Division  
Mixed Division

Net prizes will only be available to teams where all four players have a GHIN number.

### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Only the captain of each Scramble Team will receive this information. Please pass on the information to your team.

### REGISTRATION

Please check in at the registration table upon your arrival at Darlington. *Players must meet at the carts ten minutes prior to the scheduled tee time.*

### BREAKFAST

Complimentary breakfast (starting at 7:30) will be available for all players. Please do not be late for starting time.

### PRACTICE

The Darlington driving range is open.

### START OF PLAY

Please refer to the pairing sheet for your starting time and hole. Rule 6-3a states that "the player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rules 6-3a is disqualification.

### WITHDRAWAL

### CARTS AND CADDIES

Official scorecards will be distributed at the registration desk. A Scramble is scored on the honor system since no competitor is in the group to attest the score.

## PACE OF PLAY

We have a full field for this event. Slow play will not be tolerated and will be penalized appropriately. Do not allow a hole to open in front of you. Rule 5 of the Rules of Golf states in part: "The player shall play without undue delay." The penalty for breach of this Rule is two strokes in medal play.

## DIRECTIONS

DARLINGTON GOLF COURSE, MAHWAH, NJ • 201-327-8778

ROUTE 17 – Take Route 17 North to Route 202 South. Proceed past Ramapo College to Darlington Ave. and turn left. Follow to Campgaw Road and turn right. Travel 1 ¼ miles and turn left into the golf course before the Police and Fire Academy.

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY – Take Parkway North to Exit 160. Turn left at the light and proceed to Route 4 West. Take Route 4 West and bear right onto Route 208 North. Exit 208 North at Summit Ave/Franklin Lakes and make the first left. At the first light make a left onto Franklin Ave. Follow to Pulis Ave. and turn right. Take Pulis Ave. approximately 1 mile to Campgaw Road and turn left. Follow Campgaw Road 1 ½ miles and turn right immediately after the Police and Fire Academy.

GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE – Take the George Washington Bridge to Route 4 West to either Route 17 North or Route 208 North and follow the above directions.

TAPPAN ZEE BRIDGE – Take the Tappan Zee Bridge to Route 287 West to Route 17 South. Exit at Route 202 South and follow the above directions.

FROM ROUTE 287 NORTH – take Route 287 North to Route 208 South. Exit at Summit Ave/Franklin Lakes. Make the first left (following 1st sign for U-Turn). Go to the first light and make a left onto Franklin Ave. Follow to Pulis Ave. and turn right. Take Pulis Ave. approximately 1 mile to Campgaw Road and turn left. Follow Campgaw Road 1 ½ miles and turn right immediately after the Police and Fire Academy.
