Bergen County Department of Parks

The Pioneer Tour is competitive tournament golf for children ages 9-18. It is a fun way to experience competitive golf at some of the finest courses in our area. All participants are expected to understand and abide by the Rules of Golf.



Participants are divided by age into four Divisions: <u>DIV. I</u> - boys ages 16 - 18* (18 holes), <u>DIV. II</u> - boys ages 13 - 15 (18 holes), <u>DIV. III</u> - girls ages 13 - 18* (18 holes), <u>DIV. IV</u> - girls & boys ages 9 - 12 (9 holes) but **age 9-12 must first participate in the <u>Q</u> <u>TOUR</u> and be promoted by Tour Officials in order to be eligible for The Pioneer Tour.

Pairings for each event will be randomly assigned as the golfers arrive. The Pioneer Tour is an opportunity to meet new people, do not expect to be paired with friends or family.

General Information

<u>AGE REQUIREMENT</u>: Open to golfers 13-18 (*age 19 allowed if not in college yet.) **See above for 9-12 qualifications. (Age on August 1 determines division).

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: To pre-register for the Pioneer Tour please complete the application and send it to the Department of Parks Golf Office. Players wishing to register after *June 20* must do so through on-site/stand-by registration. Available spots will be filled on a first come/first serve basis. On-site/standby registration will be held before tee off at the site of each tournament.

FEE: \$20.00 application fee, plus \$15.00 per event.

<u>REFUNDS</u>: Tournaments will proceed rain or shine. Call the course on the day of the event for an update. In the event of a canceled event No Refunds are provided. Refunds will only be awarded when participants withdraw prior to Friday, June 20, 2025. Individual Tournament Fee Refunds will only be awarded if the golfer experiences a serious medical condition. Proof is required.

Participant Responsibilities

<u>MANDATORY DRESS CODE</u>: **Participants in all programs must adhere to the dress code.** Tucked in collared shirts with sleeves, golf shoes(w/non-metal spikes) or sneakers, slacks, bermuda type shorts. NOT PERMITTED: Short shorts, sweat pants, "Cargo" pants or shorts, spandex pants, bike shorts, jeans, halter tops, tank tops. Anyone not meeting dress code requirements will not be allowed to participate. NO REFUNDS.

<u>TIME</u>: Participants of The Pioneer Tour should arrive at the golf course no later than 45 minutes before starting time. Upon arrival each contestant must check in before proceeding to the range or the putting green.

WALKING THE COURSE: All participants are expected to walk the course. Pull carts are allowed, must bring own.

MAXIMUM STROKE POLICY: Divisions I, II, III and IV maximum of double par on any hole. Pioneer Points will be awarded for that days participation.

<u>SPECTATORS/VOLUNTEERS</u>: **No Spectators**. We welcome volunteers. Players will be paired randomly and volunteers will not be allowed to be with a relative/friend.
